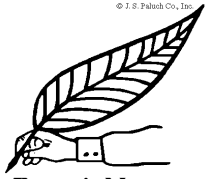

Pastor's Notes

BAKER'S BITS

1. We rejoice with Gemma, Martin, Celeste, Adam a Emily, children who will today receive their First Holy Communion in St. Frances X. Cabrini Church on Roosevelt Island. May you be always worthy of this sacrament.

2. On Monday, May 16th is the feast of co-patron of our parish Saint John Nepomucene. Here is a brief biography of our patron saint.

The canonized saint of the Catholic Church in whose honor our parish is dedicated was born about 1340 A.D. in the town of Nepomuk, district of Pilsen, in present day Czech Republic. The family name was Welfin and John's father was a Burger of the town (District leader). Our patron saint studied theology and jurisprudence at the University of Prague and in 1373 was ordained to the priesthood. About the year 1383 Father John of Nepomuk had become the confessor to Queen Johanna, first wife of King Wenceslaus, (not the one of Christmas song.) For some time the king had suspected his wife of infidelity and questioned John concerning the matter. Because confessional knowledge was involved our patron saint refused to divulge any information to the king. For this obstinacy the king placed him in prison and had him subjected to bodily torture of the severest kind. The king ordered him to be thrown into the Moldau (Vltava) river where he drowned. The exact date of his heroic death was March 20, 1393. Later his body was recovered from the river and buried in the Prague Cathedral by Archbishop John of Jensenstein. Another tradition about St. John Nepomucene speaks of the conflict between the abbot and King Wenceslaus. At issue was the appointment of a new abbot for the rich and powerful Benedictine Abbey of Kladruby; its abbot was a territorial magnate whose resources would be crucial to Wenceslaus in his struggles with nobles. Wenceslaus at the same time was backing the Avignon papacy, whereas the Archbishop of Prague followed its rival, the pope at Rome. Contrary to the wishes of Wenceslaus, John confirmed the archbishop's candidate for Abbot of Kladruby, and was drowned on the emperor's orders on March 20, 1393. John of Nepomuk was beatified in 1721 and in 1729 he was canonized a saint of the Catholic Church and declared the Patron Saint of all Bohemia. His feast day was placed in the Church calendar on May 16th.

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Pentecost Sunday is one of the most ancient feasts of the Church, celebrated early enough to be mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (20:16) and St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians (16:8). It is the 50th day after Easter (if we count both Easter and Pentecost), and it supplants the Jewish feast of Pentecost, which took place 50 days after the Passover and which celebrated the sealing of the Old Covenant on Mount Sinai. Christ had promised His Apostles that He would send His Holy Spirit, and, on Pentecost, they were granted the gifts of the Spirit. The Apostles began to preach the Gospel in all of the languages. Pentecost is often called "the birthday of the Church." On this day, with the descent of the Holy Spirit, Christ's mission is completed, and the New Covenant is inaugurated. Pentecost also marks the end of fifty day Easter season.

ORDINATION OF REV. BROTHER BERNARDINO MARIA, C.F.R.

Brother Bernardino Maria Soukup, C.F.R. will be ordained to priesthood by His Eminence Timothy Cardinal Dolan at St. Patrick's Cathedral on Saturday, May 28th at 9 A.M. Rev. Brother Bernardino will offer a Mass of Thanksgiving in St. John Nepomucene church on Monday, May 30th at 11 A.M. You are all invited to both Masses. On the table in the back of the church you will find a leaflet with a brief biography of Rev. Brother Bernardino.

BAKER'S BITS - Z PERA OTCA BAKERA

V pondelok, 16. mája je sviatok nášho patróna svätého Jána Nepomuckého. Tu je jeho stručný životopis:

SV. JÁN NEPOMUCKÝ

Sv. Ján Nepomucký sa narodil v Pomuku pri Plzni okolo roku 1345. Ján dostal vzdelanie v kláštore cisterciánov, potom v Žatci v slávnych latinských školách, a nakoniec sa dostal aj na univerzitu do Prahy, ktorú práve v tom čase založil cisár Karol IV. V roku 1370 sa Ján stal notárom a pisárom v arcibiskupskej kancelárii. Bol takisto osobným tajomníkom biskupa. V roku 1380 sa stal súčasne aj farárom vo farnosti sv. Havla v Starom meste. V rokoch 1382-1387 študoval kánonické právo v Padove, kde získal doktorát, a potom sa vrátil späť do Prahy. Stal sa kanonikom a generálnym vikárom arcibiskupstva. Mal teda na starosti veľa zodpovedných úloh v Cirkvi. Okrem toho kázaval v chráme sv. Víta a v Týnskom chráme. Bol veľmi zbožný, horlivý a svedomitý. Traduje sa, že sv. Ján je mučeníkom spovedného tajomstva. Údaje sa ho kráľ vypytoval na hriechy svojej manželky Žofie, ktorá bola veľmi nábožná. Spovedať sa chodila práve k Jánovi. Kráľ ju podozrieval z nevery, pretože sám sa tejto neresti dopúšťal. Keďže však Ján nič nevyzradil, dal ho páliť a mučiť aj iným spôsobom a nakoniec ho v noci dal odvliečiť a zhodiť z pražského mosta do rieky Vltavy. Stalo sa to 20. Marca 1393. Túto tradíciu potvrdzuje aj fakt, že jazyk sv. Jána Nepomuckého sa zachoval neporušený. Po niekoľkých dňoch jeho telo našli a pochovali v kostole sv. Kríža; neskôr ho preniesli do chrámu sv. Víta. Ďalšie informácie, ktoré máme o Jánovi hovoria o dôležitej úlohe, ktorú zohral v Jánovom živote okrem kráľa Václava IV. aj pražský arcibiskup Ján z Jenštejna. Zlé vzťahy medzi kráľom a Jenštejncom sa vyhrtili roku 1378, kedy v rímskej cirkvi prepukla pápežská schizma. Pokiaľ bol na tróne cisár Karol IV., boli medzi arcibiskupstvom a cisárskym dvorom veľmi dobré vzťahy. To sa však zmenilo nástupom Karolovho syna Václava IV., ktorý bol korunovaný za českého kráľa už ako dvojročný. Spočiatku sa držal otcovho vzoru, no neskôr sa oddal poľovačkám, zábavám. Okrem toho bol veľmi zlostný a hnevlivý. Robil si záľusk na benediktínske opátstvo v Kralupoch v západných Čechách. Keď ho však nedostal, jeho hnev sa obrátil doslova proti celej Cirkvi v Čechách. Podľa tejto tradície zajaľ Ján a dvoch ďalších arcibiskupových spolupracovníkov. Arcibiskupa nezajaľ len kvôli tomu, že ho ochránili jeho zbrojnoši. Ostatných dvoch neskôr prepustil, ale Jána dal natiahnuť na škrepec, dal ho páliť a mučiť aj iným spôsobom a nakoniec ho v noci dal odvliečiť a zhodiť z pražského mosta do rieky Vltavy. Stalo sa to 20. Marca 1393. Po niekoľkých dňoch jeho telo našli a pochovali v kostole sv. Kríža; neskôr ho preniesli do chrámu sv. Víta. Za svätého bol Ján vyhlásený v roku 1729.
