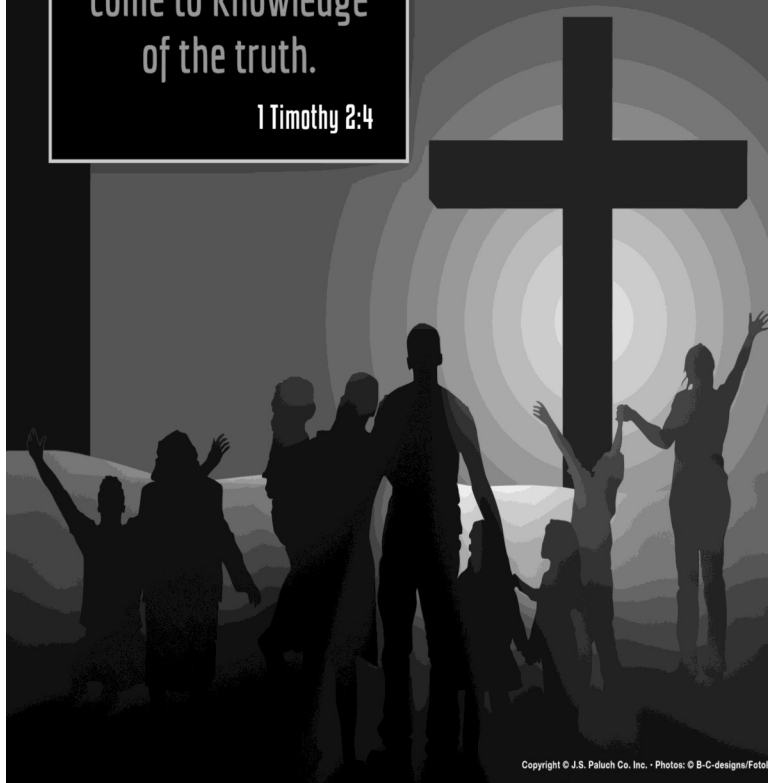

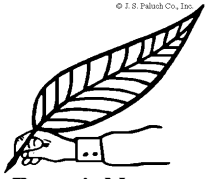

THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Anointing of the Sick is one of the seven sacraments of the Church; it is the sacrament that helps unite those who are suffering with Jesus' saving and healing power. Through this sacrament people receive forgiveness for their sins and comfort in their suffering; they are restored in spirit; and sometimes they even experience the return of physical health. "The anointing of the sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived." When there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age. The Holy Spirit renews our faith in God and helps us withstand the temptations of the Evil One to be discouraged and despairing in the face of suffering and death. Also, a sick person's sins are forgiven if he or she was not able to go to Confession prior to the celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. **In our church the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be administered every second Sunday of the month at the end of the Mass at 10:30 and 12:30 and on Roosevelt Island after the 11:15 Mass.**

SVIATOSŤ POMAZANIA CHORÝCH

Medzi siedmimi sviatosťami Katolíckej cirkvi je jedna sviatosť osobitne určená na to, aby posilňovala tých, čo sú skúšaní chorobou. Je to pomazanie chorých. "Sviatosť pomazania chorých sa udeľuje tým, čo vážne ochoreli, ale pomazanie chorých nie je sviatosťou iba pre tých, čo sa ocitajú v posledných chvíľach života. Vhodný čas na jej prijatie je už vtedy, keď veriaci začína byť pre chorobu alebo starobu v nebezpečenstve smrti. Sviatosť pomazania chorých má tieto účely: spojenie chorého s Kristovým utrpením pre jeho vlastné dobro a pre dobro celej Cirkvi; posilu, pokoj a odvalu kresťansky znášať utrpenia choroby alebo staroby; odpustenie hriechov, ak ho chorý nemohol prijať vo sviatosťi pokánia; navrátenie zdravia, ak to osoží duchovnej spásy a prípravu na prechod do večného života. Táto sviatosť je milosť posily, pokoja a odvahy na premáhanie ťažkostí, ktoré sú charakteristické pre stav ťažkej choroby alebo pre stareckú krehkosť. Táto milosť je darom Ducha Svätého, ktorý obnovuje dôveru a vieru v Boha a posilňuje proti pokušeniam zlého ducha, t. j. proti pokušeniu malomyselnosti a úzkosti pred smrťou. Táto Pánova pomoc chce prostredníctvom sily jeho Ducha priviesť chorého k uzdraveniu duše, ale aj k uzdraveniu tela, ak je to Božia vôľa. Okrem toho „ak sa dopustil hriechov, odpustia sa mu“. **V našom kostole budeme vysluhovať sviatosť pomazania chorých každú druhú nedeľu v mesiaci po sv. omši o 10.30 a 12.30 a na Roosevelt Island po sv. omši o 11.15.**

POČAS ROKU MILOSRDENSTVA NAVŠTÍVILO VEČNÉ MESTO UŽ 14 MILIÓNOV PŮTNIKOV

Podľa údajov vatikánskych úradov, od otvorenia Svätého roku milosrdenstva 8. decembra 2015 do centra katolíckeho sveta prišlo celkovo 14 202 277 veriacich, aby cez sväté brány vkročili do baziliky sv. Petra. Na želanie pápeža Františka sa Rok milosrdenstva neslávi len v Ríme, ale aj v diecézach po celom svete. V takmer 2100 diecézach na celom svete sa preto otvorilo viac než 10 000 svätých brán. Svätý rok milosrdenstva končí 20. novembra 2016.
