

SAINT BENEDICT

Benedict was born in 480 into a distinguished family in Nursia, Umbria, Italy. He studied at Rome and early in life was drawn to the monastic life. At first he became a hermit. A family of monks chose him as their leader for a while, but found his strictness not to their taste. He had an idea of gathering various families of monks into one "Grand Monastery" to give them the benefit of unity, fraternity, permanent worship in one house. Finally he began to build what was to become one of the most famous monasteries in the world—Monte Cassino. "The Rule" that gradually developed prescribed a life of liturgical prayer, study, manual labor and living together in community under a common father (abbot). Benedictine asceticism is known for its moderation, and Benedictine charity has always shown concern for the people in the surrounding countryside. He died at Monte Cassino around year 547. He was named patron protector of Europe by Pope Paul VI in 1964. In 1980, Pope John Paul II declared him co-patron of Europe, together with Saints Cyril and Methodius.

COMMUNION IN THE HAND

The American National Conference of Catholic Bishops has approved Communion in the hand. Communion in the hand should show, as much as communion on the tongue, due respect towards the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. The faithful receiving communion should place the left hand upon the right hand, so that the sacred host can be conveyed to the mouth with the right hand. The communicant who received the Eucharist in the hand is to consume it before returning to his place, moving aside yet remaining facing the altar in order to allow the person following to approach the priest. Out of respect for the Eucharist, cleanliness of hands is expected.

SVÄTÝ BENEDIKT Z NURSIE ALEBO SVÄTÝ BEŇADIK sa narodil okolo roku 480 v mestečku Nursia (Norcia) v Umbrii, Taliansko. Vzdelanie nadobudol v Ríme, potom viedol asketický život v Sabínskych horách, striedavo žil ako pustovník a ako predstavený pustovníkov. Roku 529 založil prvý samostatný západoeurópsky kláštor Mons Casinus (Monte Cassino), z ktorého sa benediktínsky rád rozšíril po celej Európe a ovplyvnil aj všetky ostatné rády. Bol to kláštor s jasne stanovenými pravidlami - regulami, kde bola zahrnutá povinnosť vzdelávania. Kláštor ako vzdelávacia inštitúcia mal dve oddelenia: vonkajšie (určené na vzdelávanie laikov - synov bohatých feudálov) a vnútorné (na vzdelávanie mníchov). Pretože sv. Benedikt si neobyčajne vážil antickú literatúru a dával ju vo svojom kláštore opisovať, boli tu založené základy pre rozvoj poantickej kultúry v Európe. Sv. Benedikt zomrel okolo roku 547 v Monte Cassino. Bol zakladateľ západoeurópskeho mníšstva a v roku 1964 ho pápež Pavol VI. ustanovil za hlavného patróna Európy. V roku 1980 ho pápež Ján Pavol II vyhlásil za spolu-patróna Európy so sv. Cyrilom a Metodom.

PRIJÍMANIE NA RUKU

Všeobecné smernice Rímskeho misála rozoznávajú dva spôsoby prijatia Sviatosti, buď do úst alebo na ruku. Americká Národná Konferencia Katolíckych Biskupov schválila prijímanie na ruku. Prijímanie na ruku musí ukázať taký istý rešpekt a úctu k Eucharistii, ako prijímanie do úst. Prijímajúci predstúpi pred kňaza, položí otvorenú ľavú ruku na pravú, aby potom mohol položiť hostiu do úst pravou rukou; kňaz položí hostiu prijímajúcemu do otvorenej dlane. Prijímajúci prijme svätú hostiu hneď pred oltárom a celú ju zje, môže ustúpiť trocha nabok, aby uvoľnil miesto daľšiemu veriacmu, aby mohol predstúpiť pred kňaza.
