POPE FRANCIS NAMES THE MOST REVEREND MILAN LACH, SJ, AS BISHOP OF THE RUTHENIAN EPARCHY OF PARMA

Pope Francis has appointed as Bishop of the Ruthenian Eparchy of Parma, the Most Reverend Milan Lach, SJ, who up until now served as apostolic administrator of the Eparchy. The Byzantine Catholic Eparchy of Parma is the Catholic eparchy governing most Ruthenian Catholics in the mid-western United States. It is headquartered in Parma, Ohio. Bishop Lach, 44, was born in Kežmarok, Slovakia in 1973. In 1995 he entered the novitiate of the Society of Jesus in Trnava, Slovakia. He was ordained a deacon of the Society of Jesus on November 11, 2000 and was ordained a priest on July 1, 2001. In 2009 he obtained a master's degree from the Eastern Church Sciences and later, a doctorate degree at the Pontifical Oriental Institute in Rome. He was appointed auxiliary bishop of Prešov and titular bishop of Ostracine on April 19, 2013. He was ordained as auxiliary bishop of Prešov and titular bishop of Ostracine, June 1, 2013. On June 24, 2017, Pope Francis named Bishop Lach as apostolic administrator of the sede vacante (vacant see) of the Eparchy of Parma for the Ruthenians. By being appointed a Bishop of Parma he is no longer a titular bishop of Ostracine.

Sister Nadine Koza, a native of New York City, is a member of St. John Nepomucene/St. Frances Xavier Parish in New York. She received her Masters degree in Mathematics from the University of Notre Dame, Indiana and Masters in Pastoral Studies from Loyola University in Chicago, IL. She completed her CPE (Clinical pastoral education) Residency at Methodist Hospital in Brooklyn, NY and is a certified Chaplain by the National Association of Catholic Chaplains. She currently ministers at Mount Sinai Hospital in New York City as a staff chaplain in the Hematology/Oncology/Stem Cell Transplant unit. Sister Nadine entered the Joliet Franciscans in May 1976. Her faith home is St. Frances Xavier Church where she serves as a liturgical minister. Every year around the Feast of St. Francis she organizes a Blessing of Animals in celebrations of this feast. The Mass to celebrate her anniversary will be on June 23rd at St. Raymond Cathedral in Joliet, IL.

Svätý Otec František vymenoval vладыku Milana Lacha SJ za biskupa Ruténskej (gréckokatolíckej) eparchie Parma v USA. Parmskú eparchiu v štáte Ohio 44-ročný slovenský jezuita doteraz spravoval ako apoštolský administrátor sede vacante. Eparcha Milan Lach sa narodil 18. novembra 1973 v Kežmarku. V roku 1995 vstúpil do noviciátu Spoločnosti Ježišovej v Trnave a v roku 2001 prijal v Košiciach kňazskú vysviacku. V roku 2009 obhájil doktorát z východných cirkevných vied na Pápežskom východnom inštitúte v Ríme. Dňa 19. apríla 2013 ho Svätý Otec František vymenoval za pomocného biskupa Prešovskej gréckokatolíckej archieparchie s titulárnym sídlom Ostracine. Dňa 24. júna 2017 ho pápež František menoval apoštolským administrátorom sede vacante Ruténskej eparchie Parma v USA, pričom zostal titulárnym biskupom ostracinským. Aktuálnym menovaním sa vладыka Milan Lach SJ stal sídelným biskupom parmským a nie je viac titulárnym biskupom.
